## A Position of Service

- The colors were important because those were also the colors of the tabernacle's curtains and veils, so the priest matched the tabernacle. The colors showed that the priest and the tabernacle went together. // Allan Moseley "Exalting Jesus in Leviticus"
- even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. // Matthew 20:28

- Aaron and his sons are anointed with oil to signify being separated out for a purpose.
- Anointed is the word Meshiach (this is where we get the word Messiah/Christ)
- Anointing is a symbol that refers to God blessing us with position and power. // Allan Moseley "Exalting Jesus in Leviticus"
